Chaperone Duties and Guidelines

Guidelines for Rehearsal

- Sign up for a shift through the Link. You will not be considered as a chaperone unless you have signed up or spoken to Jessica Taylor.
- Arrive 10 minutes before the shift starts (unless advised otherwise).
- Get the medical bag and blue ice cooler from the guard room. The ice cooler should be filled with ice from the Wrestling room (in the basement of the school).
- Pull a table and 2 chairs to sit. Place the Medical bag and the ice on the table after you get inside and set up.
- You will sit at the table for the durations of your shift.
- Monitor students leaving the rehearsal area – watch for bathroom breaks.
- Check on students that have been away from rehearsal for long periods of time.
- If a student is injured or ill, please ensure that it is annotated in the medical logbook in the medical bag. Assess injuries and illnesses.

- Encourage students to return to rehearsal after a brief time has passed, if able. (Students should not be on their phones)
- In the event there is a serious emergency please alert the Guard/Band Director (onsite) and then call Jessica 910-233-7354. The Director should call 911.
- While on chaperone duties, parents will not engage/interrupt at any time during rehearsal. This means, you will not make corrections to students or speak directly to coaches. (If a parent has a concern, please email/call Jessica Taylor)
- Please be aware of the students and what is going on around you. You are there for the safety of our students.
- Be flexible and willing to help where needed.

Chaperone Duties and Guidelines for Competition

- Arrive 15 minutes before call time, unless you have let the head chaperone know you will be late.
- Get a chaperone badge and arm band from the head chaperone (if chosen to be a chaperone you will get a ticket free).
- Lead Chaperones will take roll before we depart Mill Creek, at the destination make sure to account for all the students on your list.
- Lead Chaperone will check each student out at the end of the day.
- Follow students to the trailer and Hallway area, stay with students as they block up and prepare for the show. The Coach will take them from here. You are there just to make sure all are safe.
- Lead Chaperone will walk through with the student and coach. All other chaperones will head to the gym to be a cheer section for the students.
- IF YOU ARE NOT ON THE LIST OF CHAPERONES, YOU DO NOT GET A CHAPERONE BADGE NOR CAN YOU WALK IN WITH THE GUARD. NO FORMER MEMBERS, NON-CHAPERONES, SIBLINGS, CAN WALK IN WITH THE GUARD THROUGH THE WARMUP.
- Be flexible and willing to help where needed.
- Be aware of the students and what is going on around you. We are there for the safety and protection of our students.
- Students can go to the restroom, (two or more should go together). During the time seated in the gym, Students and Chaperons will sit together. (Students are allowed to concession stands, and vendors)
- Chaperone will ensure the Guard cleans up any trash that has been left in the hallway and gym. At the end of the event, stay with the students as they put their guard equipment on the trailers.
- Lead Chaperon will communicate text with any information to parents via the Guard Parent Group me.
